House Rules – Staying with Your Pet

Welcome!

At the Green Hotel Genzianella, pets are warmly welcome — we want your four-legged friends to enjoy a pleasant and memorable stay too.

In the surrounding area, you'll find many walking and hiking trails within the Adamello Brenta Nature Park, perfect for outdoor adventures with your dog — both in summer and winter.

In your room, you'll find a pet bed, food and water bowl, waste bags, and a small welcome treat for your travel companion.

Main Rules

- Our “Pet Friendly” rooms are subject to availability; please inform us at the time of booking if you're travelling with a dog.
- Up to two dogs per room are allowed, unless otherwise agreed with the Reception.
- Dogs are welcome in the breakfast room and restaurant, but not allowed in the SPA area.
- A daily supplement of €20.00 applies to cover additional cleaning and sanitizing costs.

During Your Stay

- Dogs must be kept on a leash in all public areas.
- They may be left alone in the room only if the owner is staying in the hotel and the “Do Not Disturb” sign is displayed. In this case, the housekeeping service might not be carried out.
- Please ensure that your pet does not cause any disturbance or damage (e.g. persistent barking).
- The owner is responsible for any damage caused to property or persons and must provide compensation if required.

Good to Know

About 500 meters from the hotel, you'll find the Roncone Lake Park, a perfect place for your dog to run and play freely.
